CRIME REPORTING

The Enoch Police Department is launching a new program where mobile phone users can send anonymous tips to the police department online, or by sending a text message to "CRIMES" (274637) with the keyword "ENOCHTIP" from a mobile phone. The service is called TipSoft and specifically allows text message providers to remain anonymous by encrypting the text messages, assigning them a unique alias and ID, and routing them through secure servers, protecting the personal details of the information provider. Citizens are encouraged to use TipSoft to report information about any non-urgent illegal activity, such as unsolved cases, vandalism, theft, the sale and distribution of drugs or information about crimes that are being planned in the community or in schools.
